As an important reminder, the school day begins at 9:00 AM. Doors open for students at 8:45 AM. Children should NOT be left on school property before that time, as there will be no supervision. Students should be in their classrooms promptly by 9:00 AM to begin their morning routines and morning work. Students arriving after this time will report to the main office to sign in. Depending on the arrival time, students will be marked tardy ½ day.

Text STOP to 67587 at any time to stop receiving text message alerts from CCPS. Standard text message rates by cell phone carriers apply. This feature is available only to parents.
- Notification by Charles County CNS: Receive free email and text message notifications from the Citizen Notification Service (CNS). Visit <u>http://www.charlescountymd.gov/CNS</u> to sign up. Select Charles County Public Schools notifications.
- Notification by press release: CCPS will post a weather alert press release any time school status is affected by inclement weather.
