Important Information

- Parents WILL NOT be permitted to enter the building during student arrival & dismissal.
- Car riders should enter the **lower** parking lot, off Willow lane, forming **three lines** and waiting at the stop sign. Mr. Margolis will <u>direct</u> you when to pull up and drop off curbside. During dismissal, we will load **nine cars** at a time. Students should enter/exit curbside where a Mitchell staff member will greet them. Parents should <u>remain</u> in their car and should <u>refrain</u> from passing other <u>vehicles</u>.
- CCPS has an automated system that provides a phone call report to the parent/guardian listed on file in the student information system when a student is late and/or absent. Starting Tuesday, Sept. 6, attendance calls will begin for the 2022-2023 school year. Tardy notifications are generally sent around 10:30 a.m., while absence notification calls begin at 6 p.m.
- The CCPS Food and Nutrition Services Department continues to process completed free and reduced-price meal applications. Paper copies were sent home with students last week; the application is also available to complete online at https://www.myschoolapps.com/. Parents with multiple students enrolled in CCPS only need to complete one application. The information provided will be used to determine a child's eligibility for free or reduced-priced meals.

CCPS Cell Phone Policy: Students may only bring their phone or device with approval from the principal. Please email Mr. Adam at nadam@ccboe.com. Once approved, students <a href="mailto:must keep their phone or device powered completely off (not on vibrate or silent mode) and inside their book bag throughout the entirety of each school day. Once approved for school, students may use their phone or device on the bus, but use must not be disruptive or cause a distraction to the driver at any time. Sound must only be audible through headphones. Phone conversations are prohibited.



Attendance Matters: Regular school attendance positively influences student achievement. Students should attend school daily. In the event your student is absent, please send a written note regarding the reason for the absence with your student upon his/her return. Students should give the note to their classroom teacher or you can email them directly to Ms. Gomez, at dgomez@ccboe.com



All students will be provided with a Thursday folder. The folder will be sent home with your child each Thursday and should be returned to school on Friday. School and PTO communication, as well as important classroom information like graded papers, field trip information and community event

fliers, will be sent home in Thursday folders.


